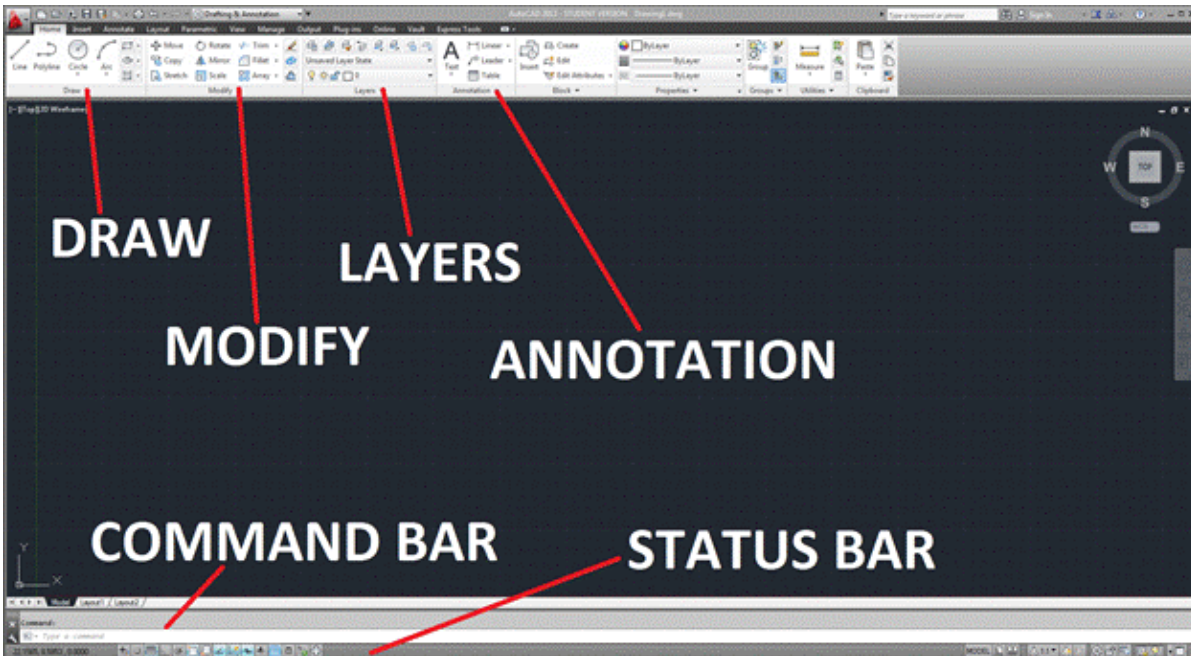

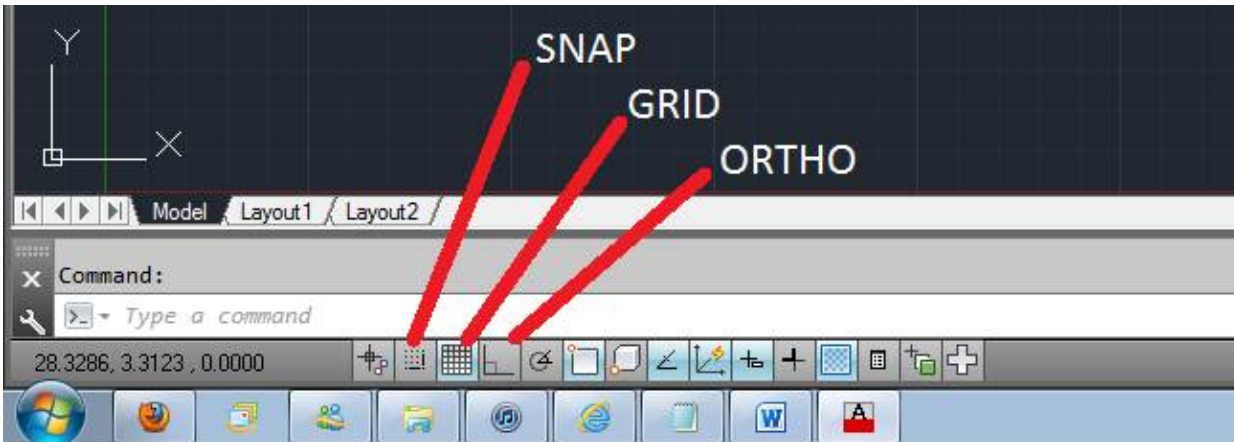
## THE MAIN SCREEN

When AutoCAD opens, you are presented with this screen:



## ASSISTS

There are a couple of tools that you will find most helpful!

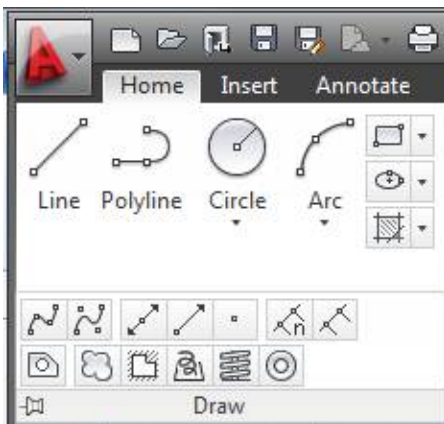


**GRID:** Places dots on the screen much like graph paper lines

**SNAP:** Restricts the cursor to move only on the GRID dots

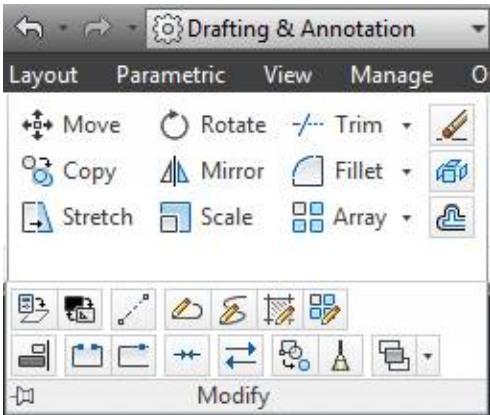
**ORTHO:** Restricts the cursor to move **ONLY** horizontally or vertically

## THE DRAW TOOLBOX

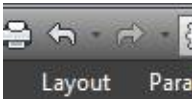


**HOVER** over any button icon to get more information about what it does.

## THE MODIFY TOOLBOX



## UNDO and REDO



**THESE** are your friends, especially as you learn this.

## SAVE
